




- No upgrade from 2007

 - Hierarchy wide Boot image
 - Pre-execution hook
- Packages and Programs
- Desired Configuration Management (DCM) now called Compliance Settings
- Software Updates



Service Pack 1

- What is new
 - Support for Windows 8 and Windows Server 2012
 - SUP can now use an upstream WSUS server
 - We can add a CAS later
 - We can migrate a 2012 site to another 2012 site
 - Agents for OSX and Linux
 - Connection with Windows Intune
 - Windows Embedded Management

Be informed before installing SP1

System Center 2012 SP1 Woes, Gotchas, and Workarounds http://myitforum.com/myitforumwp/docs/configuration-manager-2012-sp1-issues-andresolutions/

- Disable the Anti Virus scanner on the ConfigMgr server during update
- If you want to use OSD with ConfigMgr 2012 SP1 your hardware must support booting from Windows 8 (vSphere 4 not supported)
- You can not install Windows 7 using Original Installation Source (setup.exe)
 - Use TS Variable OSDPreserveDriveletter=False
- SUP configuratie gets reset to :80 & :443 instead of 8530 & 8531
- Some RTM applications are broken and need to be updated
